



REFLECTION, TWELFTH SUNDAY (B)

In the gospel passage of today Jesus was in the boat with his disciples when a great storm arose and beat into the boat, that it was almost filling with water. But Jesus was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. To sleep through such a terrible storm, Jesus must have been very tired. Overcome by fear, the disciples woke him up saying, "Teacher, do you not care if we perish?" And he woke up and rebuked the wind and the sea saying, "Peace! Be still." And the storm ceased. And Jesus said to them, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?" And the disciples in a state of alarm asked themselves, "Who then is this, that even the wind and sea obey him?"

The answer to their question, "Who then is this, that even the wind and sea obey him?" is found in the first reading and the responsorial psalm of today. In the first reading God tells Job how he created the seas and put their boundaries. Psalm 107: 6, 29 tells us about sailors caught in a storm and, "In their trouble they called to the Lord, and he saved them...He calmed the raging storm, and the waves became quiet." Jesus does what the scriptures say God did because he is God.

The question of the disciples show their ignorance of the true identity of Jesus. If they knew that the person with them was the God who created the seas and defined their boundaries, If they knew that it was the same God who saved the sailors in the storm when they called upon him, then whether he was asleep or awake, there was no difference.

Sometimes we find ourselves in danger and do not feel the presence of God and we begin to panic. That is a sign of lack of faith in the God who is able to save us whether he is awake or asleep, near or far. Have faith and call on God any time and he will surely save you.
