REFLECTION for Twenty-Seventh Sunday (B)

The readings of today tell us how God started the sacred institution of marriage and how Jesus elevated it to the level of a sacrament. No matter the progress made by humanity in different fields, marriage must always be viewed with the lens of the sacred. If God is taken out of that sacred institution, it ceases to be marriage.

As Jesus was speaking some people brought little children to him that he may touch them, but his disciples tried to stop them. Jesus told them not to stop them. Then he added, "Whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter."

A child has childlike wonder in the parents. Childlike wonder is that feeling of love, trust, amazement, admiration, which a child has towards the parents. To the child there is nothing the parents cannot do; there is nothing beyond the capacity of the parents. There is a sense of wonder and admiration at what the parents can do especially, to protect and provide.

It is this sense of wonder and admiration or faith which Jesus asks us to have in God. Just as a child has unflinching trust and faith in the parents, so too we should in God. No matter how difficult or perilous the situation, we must trust in God as children trust in parents.

Many in the world today have lost that sense of wonder and trust in God. And that is why many find it difficult to pray or worship. It is the reason that many no longer go to Church and the percentage of those who go to church on Sunday continues fall.

When the sense of wonder in God begins to die, then also the sense of prayer and worship will die. According to the great missionary Albert Schweitzer, "The tragedy of life is what dies inside us while we live." When we become blind to the fingerprints of God in the beauty and awesomeness of creation, when we become deaf to the voice of God in the gentle breeze and the singing of birds in the world around us, then we have lost the sense of wonder, then something, something great has died inside us.

Let us be kind to children, the poor and the weak in our midst, let us appreciate God in the beauty and grandeur of His creation, so that we may rediscover the childlike sense of wonder in God and discover anew how to pray and worship God.
