

REFLECTION for Christmas (C)

At Christmas we celebrate the greatest Divine gift to us. At creation God gave us the gift of life but at redemption he gave us the gift of his son. Christmas is God saying to humanity, "I love you so much that I gave you, love, my son."

Fr Mark Link in his book "Sunday Homilies" told the story of a young boy who wanted to know the language that God speaks. He asked his teachers, the elders and wise people in his neighbourhood, but none knew. Then one day, as he slept, he saw a vision of the child Jesus in the manger in Bethlehem. He was told in the dream that his search for the language God speaks was over. He was told to look at the baby Jesus lying in the manger, and he would understand God's language.

God speaks the language of love. "...God so loved the world that he gave his only son (to the world) (Jn 3: 16). The young boy fell on his knees in front of the baby Jesus and shed tears of joy. Now he knew the language of God. God speaks the language of love. God speaks the one language that every person, of every nation, of every age can understand.

He was given a message in the dream. It is not enough to know the language that God speaks, you must tell everyone about the language God speaks. When he woke up, he reasoned to himself, 'If I am to tell everyone the language God speaks, and if they are to believe me, I am going to have to speak the language of love myself.' It is the only language that everybody in the world understands.

From that day the young man began to speak the language that God speaks. He began to speak the language of love. He discovered to his utter amazement that the more he spoke to people in the language of love, the more they responded to him in the same language. And the more people he spoke to in the language of love, the more they spoke to others in the same language, and the more others understood and spoke.

Christmas is a celebration of the love of God, given to us to be enjoyed and shared. Let us speak the language of God, the language of love to the people of our time.

Love and peace of Jesus. Merry Christmas.
