REFLECTION The Holy Family of Jesus

, Mary and Joseph (C)/ Mary Mother of God, –New Year 2025

Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It is a unique family where the baby of the family is the greatest, and the actual head and maker of the family. It is a family where it is the child who brought the family together and the family is united in him. No child chooses his parents; but with the Holy family of Nazareth, Jesus chose his parents. He chose Joseph the just man to be the human head and guardian and the Immaculate Virgin Mary to be the mother. It is no coincidence that this feast is celebrated within the octave of Christmas. Christmas gives us a complete picture of the Holy family.

The human family has its origin in God. It was God who originated and initiated the idea of the family. In the Book of Genesis 22: 21 he created the first human family. Though Adam and Eve, the first parents of the human family, fell short and disobeyed God, God did not abandon his original idea to have the human family. Despite the fall and disobedience, God 'perfected' the idea of the family; and corrected the wrong of Adam and Eve in the Holy family of Nazareth, with Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

The holy family is the perfect reflection and example of what a human family should be and look like. A family built on love of God and love of man. A family that has God as the head, a family that has God at the centre; a family that is always in constant touch with God.

It was not a family without problems. No. It had its fair share of problems. Joseph was confused about what to do with Mary after she got pregnant. Mary was in labour and had no place to deliver her baby. At the presentation of Jesus in the Temple, Simeon said things about the child that must have troubled the mother, Mary. "This child is set for the fall and rising of many in Israel...And a sword will pierce your soul...." (Lk 2: 34ff) The family must have been a poor because what they took for the presentation at the Temple was what was expected of the poor who could not afford a ram. (Gen 15: 9; Lk 2: 24) Joseph was asked in a dream to flee to Egypt with the child because his life was in danger. At the age of twelve, they lost him for three days.

As we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, the holy family of Nazareth, let us thank God for the gift of this wonderful family, the model of all families.
