REFLECTION - Solemnity of Corpus Christi

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. In the Eucharist Christ gives us himself; he nourishes us with his body and blood so that we can draw life from him just as he draws life from the Father. As he says explicitly about the life-giving power of the Eucharist, "I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever."

In approaching the Eucharist, we must always remember that the Eucharist is not an "ordinary bread". It is the body and blood of Christ under the appearance of bread and wine. When we receive the Eucharist in this spirit and treat it as such, it makes a huge difference in our life. For the Eucharist to have maximum impact we must receive it with faith; we must look beyond the bread and perceive it as truly the body and blood of Christ. Making that transition is an act of faith and as we act in faith, its reality takes firm root in us.

As we celebrate the solemnity of the Corpus Christi today, we have a great opportunity to examine our attitudes towards the Eucharist. Do I really believe that what I receive is the body and blood, soul, and divinity of Christ under the appearance of bread and wine? If I truly believe this, do I treat the Eucharist with the respect it deserves as the body and blood of Christ?

The Eucharist is our source of nourishment. If we receive it in a state of grace and approach it with due reverence, we will grow from strength to strength and be drawn more and more into communion with Christ and with Christ leading us into each occasion and situation we have enough resources to deal with the challenges of life.

Lord, thank you for the gift of your body and blood. Help me to always receive the Eucharist with gratitude and appreciation.
