

# REFLECTION, Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe With our celebration today of the Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, we come to the end of the

With our celebration today of the Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, we come to the end of the Liturgical year. The solemnity of Christ the king reminds us of the final victory of Christ, the fact that Christ will hand over the kingdom to God after enduring much suffering, on account of his mission of saving mankind. Christ's triumph over death and Satan is evidence of God's fidelity. Having burdened him with the task of saving mankind and establishing the reign of God on earth, God could not have allowed his enemies to prevail over him. Thus, if Christ suffered and endured shame it was only for a while. Christ himself was aware of this and he never doubted his Father's fidelity even at the heart of his passion; hence the courage and perseverance he demonstrated.

In celebrating the kingship of Christ his faithfulness, no less than the fidelity of God, provides us plenty of food for thought. Yes, God the father was faithful to his son. Yet if his son had been unfaithful, the project would not have succeeded. On the contrary Christ was faithful from start to finish, from the incarnation to the resurrection and even beyond – if we consider that he sits now at the right hand of the Father where he continues to intercede for us in ceaseless application of his paschal mystery to our cause. Indeed, in his characteristic humility, Christ accepted the will of the Father despite the inherent contradiction involved in his passion.

Yet in submitting himself to all this in the spirit of filial obedience, he did not allow himself to be deterred by persecution, which virtually became his daily food, despite all his good works. Paradoxically his patience, humility and love will turn out to be his greatest strength; the secret of his victory in the end. Indeed, as he once taught his disciples, his perseverance turned out to be his greatest investment. For, the Father vindicated him when it mattered most and put all his detractors to shame by raising him from the dead. Instructively in doing this, God transformed the cross, the instrument of his punishment and humiliation, into an instrument of salvation – a means through which everyone will make their return to God

Jesus, we must learn the importance of faithfulness and perseverance. No victory comes easily. No success comes without sweat. The way to win is to remain steadfast. The whole point of our Christian life is to achieve heaven at the end of our lives here on earth. This can never come to us easily. It will involve struggle at various levels. Unless we are prepared to hold on to the end, we may never come through successfully. In the process we are bound to face many temptations but if we fix our gaze on Christ we will receive not only inspiration but also strength and confidence to persevere, despite all odds, until we arrive safely at our heavenly destination.

The solemnity of Christ the King is a sure guarantee of our victory. It assures us that if we unite ourselves with Christ and allow him to lead and guide us through every moment of our lives, we will eventually come to take the place he has made ready for us in heaven. We must not allow what he has invested in us, at a huge cost, to be in vain. His blood, shed for our redemption, must yield abundant and positive fruits in our lives. It must yield the fruit of obedience, fruit of repentance; it must yield fruits of faith, hope and love and perseverance—fruits that will sustain us on our journey in this vale of tears until we arrive safely at his feet in heaven.
