


REFLECTION, Second Sunday in Ordinary Time (A)

Our vocation as Christians is to bear witness to Christ. Unless we are sign posts that point others to Christ, we cannot say we are true Christians. To live, such as to lead others to Christ, our lives must resemble the life of Christ. We should not be excessively attached to things of this world and it should be evident from the way we carry on, that our whole life is dependent on God; that we live for God and not merely for ourselves or for others.

This is one basic lesson we can deduce from the lifestyle of John the Baptist. The figure of John the Baptist may strike us as strange, yet it speaks of a life sunk in God and lived totally for the service of God and humanity. Indeed, his unusual lifestyle tells us that in order to be effective witness of Christ in our contemporary situation our lives must not only correspond with the life of Christ but, more importantly, we need a bit of distance from the world in order to see things as they really are.

Living with an awareness of our pilgrim status is always the result a spirit-filled life. Indeed, if our life is animated by the Spirit, we will be so attuned to the voice of God, that we always recognize the signs of time and not be preoccupied with or misled by mere appearances.

This is precisely the situation of John the Baptist in the gospel. Because John was not engrossed in the world but lived a spirit-filled life, he was able to recognize Christ and pointed him out as the Lamb of God.

That John succeeded in recognizing him and introducing him to the world is all down the spirit-filled life he led, so that it is evident that we cannot make a success of our vocation unless we are animated by the Holy Spirit. We certainly cannot walk in the footsteps of Christ or assume his attitudes and dispositions in various contexts of our everyday life, unless we are spirit-filled persons and we follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

Same is true about the task of introducing Christ to others. We cannot be effective sign posts that lead others to Christ unless we are moved by the Holy Spirit. Indeed, if we are moved by the spirit and follow the promptings of the Spirit, everything about us and everything we do becomes a means through which Christ reveals his presence in our lives and situations and so draws others to himself through our instrumentality.

The truth is if, like John the Baptist and Christ, we learn to dwell in communion with the spirit and follow his promptings, we will not only understand what God demands of us but we shall also have the courage and strength to do it, regardless of the challenges involved. Because we have the discernment that comes from the Holy Spirit, we will avoid the deceptions of this world and this can only mean that our lives will be fruitful and productive.
